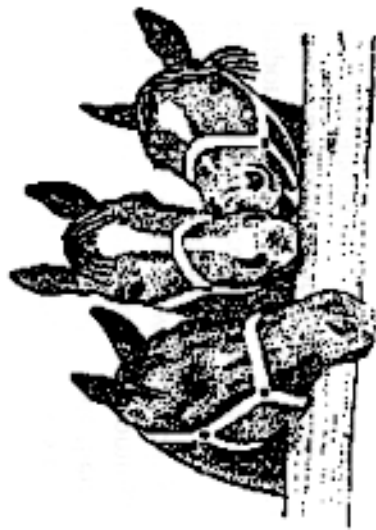

Who We Are & What We Do

H.O.R.S.E. Rescue & Sanctuary, founded in 1995, cares for those horses that no one else will care for. We provide food, shelter, rehabilitation, medical care, and adoption services for horses that have been abused, abandoned or neglected.

Volunteers comprise the H.O.R.S.E. Rescue & Sanctuary and donate their time to feeding, exercising, grooming, and cleaning stalls, as well as facility maintenance, fundraising, public education and special events. Most important, our volunteers provide daily love and attention for those horses awaiting adoption.

H.O.R.S.E. Rescue & Sanctuary's adoption service strives to find new caring homes for the horses sheltered at the rescue. Potential adopters are screened, and an effort is made to match a horse with a compatible new owner. Site checks are made as well as follow up visits.

H.O.R.S.E. Rescue & Sanctuary achieves results with the help of our volunteers and the generosity of private and corporate sponsors, (no salaries are paid).

Frequently Asked Questions

What is H.O.R.S.E. Rescue's adoption policy?

The adoption contract provides that the horse will never be sold, given away, or disposed of in any manner other than returning to H.O.R.S.E. Rescue & Sanctuary.

Where do the horses come from?

Most of the horses come from owners who can no longer care for them. Some are abandoned at local boarding stables.

Does H.O.R.S.E. Rescue impound neglected horses?

No, we do not have the authority to take a horse from someone. We are a shelter and receive horses by donation. We may care for horses at the request of state and local agencies.

Does H.O.R.S.E. Rescue take any horse?

Usually, but we are a small organization with limited resources. Our goal is to place as many horses in new homes as possible.

Can I adopt a horse if I have never owned a horse?

Yes. We do require someone with little or no experience to work with the horse in our care to gain experience before letting the horse go to its new home. We are always available to answer questions or help if needed.
